Covid-19 Protocols

The University of Vermont requires adherence to the following protocols for all public events. By returning the enclosed registration form you agree to the following policies for yourself and all of your guests:

- It is expected that attendees coming to the UVM Campus have been fully vaccinated for COVID-19.
- No person with symptoms of respiratory illness may enter UVM facilities or be allowed on UVM grounds.
- If persons have any of the following symptoms, or have had them in the previous 72 hours, and these symptoms cannot be attributed to any pre-existing condition, they may not come on-site:
 - 1. Cough
 - 2. Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - 3. Congestion or runny nose
 - 4. Sore throat
 - 5. New loss of taste or small
 - 6. Fever a temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or higher
 - 7. Chills
 - 8. Fatigue
 - 9. Headache
 - 10. Muscle pain or body pain
 - 11. Nausea or vomiting
 - 12. Diarrhea
- Individuals 65 and over, and those with underlying medical conditions should use increased safety precautions.

Parking

Parking is free in any University of Vermont parking lot on weekends. Limited parking will be available at the Silver Pavilion.
